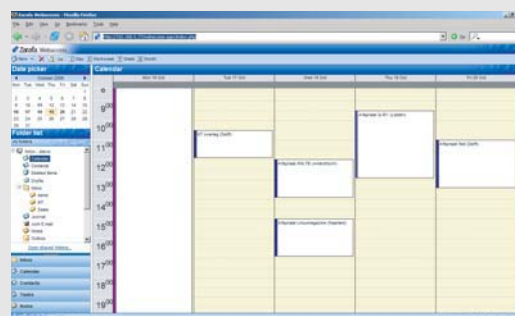
» Zarafa is the MS Exchange replacement for Linux servers, which allows you to share your e-mail, calendar and contacts via Outlook or Webaccess. With the AJAX based Zarafa webaccess you can access all your Outlook data in the same "Look & Feel" as Outlook. With the Active Directory plugin Zarafa can be easily integrated in your existing Windows network.

Outlook features

» Email

Basic mail features	Reply, forward, copy, move and print email
Multiple format	Send email in HTML, RTF or plain text format
Importants flags	Send flag which display low/norman/high importance
Wizard rules	Organise and move your e-mail to subfolders to work more effective
Junk mail control	Spam e-mails are automatically moved to your Junk E-mail folder
Reply to address	Change the reply-to address in the send email
Read receipt support	See when somebody reads your e-mail
Multiple account	Send email as another user for example info@zarafa.com
Follow up flags	Set flags for important emails
New mail notifications	Receive pop-ups after new emails will arrive

Basic calendar features	Create, move, copy, delete appointments
Recurrent items	Make recurrent appointments
Reminders	Get a pop-up before a meeting
Meeting request	Invite people for a meeting by sending them a meeting request
Freebusy times	See when your colleagues are available or in a meeting and plan a
Share your calendar with your colleagues	Use the default "Exchange" buttons, to open shared calendars
Resources support	Schedule a resource such as a meeting room or a beamer for a meeting
Category support	Set the category per calendar item
Private item support	Set private flag for appointment so your colleagues cannot see a
Multiple calendars in one view	This is a Outlook 2003 feature.

Basic contact features	Create, move, copy, delete contacts
Distributionlist support	Create distributionlist for sending email to multiple contacts
Send vcards	Send contact business cards to other people by email
Global Addressbook	Automatic resolving of internal emailaddresses

Basic task features	Create, move, copy, delete tasks
Send task requests	Assign task to your colleagues by email

	Mobile webaccess for PDA's and smartphones	Access your email, calendar and contacts via a mobile webaccess with 320x240 resolution on your PDA
	Drag & Drop items to subfolders	Organise your email in the same way as Outlook
	Right mouse click on items and folders	Delete, print, reply, forward mail direct via right mouse button
	Freebusy times	See when your colleagues are available or in a meeting and plan a meeting in only 10 seconds.

	Security Permissions	Set the permissions on your calendar and other folders, to share your items with your colleagues
	Emailaddress completion	Emailaddress completion of earlier used emailaddresses

	Multiple from addresses	Send your email with another from address
	New email notifications	Receive a message when new email is received

	Multi user calendar	Overview of multiple calendars below each other
	Groups / Distributionlists	Create distributionlist for sending email to multiple contacts
	Signature support	A signature will be default under each send email message
	Multiple format	Send email in either plain text or HTML
	Flags	Organise your email by setting flags
	Contact card view	See all your contacts in the business card view, just like Outlook
	Print function	Print your emails, calendar items or contacts
	Multiple calendar views	View your calendar in a day, workweek, 7 day week or month view
	Search	Search for emails on body, subject, To, From or cc
	Sorting	Sort your email on subject, date, from address, size

»	Advanced ACL system	Possibility to set the security permissions on every single folder
	Secure remote access	Secure remote Outlook access is possible via SSL
	Privilege separation	Run Zarafa processes as non-root user
	SSL support for IMAP / POP3 gateway	Access your email via secure POP3 or IMAP
	Multiple server	Possibility to run critical services on different servers

Management

»	Integration with LDAP server	Zarafa can easily integrated with any OpenLDAP or eDirectory server
	Integration with ADS	Zarafa can easily integrated with Active Directory servers
	Synchronisation with unix users	Zarafa can intgrated with your existing Linux users in /etc/passwd
	Graphical (user)management interface	Graphical LDAP usermanager for Redhat and Centos

Other features

»	Public folders	Keep a central calendar and contact folders wo which everbody has access
	IMAP / POP3 gateway	Access your email via different POP3 or IMAP client, like Thunderbird and Outlook Express
	Softdelete system	Every deleted item can be kept in database for 30 days, so the user can restore it in 5 seconds
	Quota support per user	Limit the size of mailboxes
	Integration with MTA	Use your existing Linux MTA, like Postfix, Qmail, Sendmail or Exim and integrate Zarafa with it.
	Integration with antispam and antivirus software	Because of the integration with different Linux MTA's, Zarafa can also be integrated with several antispam and antivirus software
	Out of Office message	Set your Out of Office message via Outlook or the webaccess
	Offline support	Support for offline synchronization of your mailbox
	Synchronisation with PDA	Synchronise your PDA or Smartphone by USB or bluetooth
	Remote Activesync on PDA	Synchronise your ActiveSync compatible PDA or Smartphone via UTMS or GPRS with Zarafa
	Push Mail support	Push mail support for Windows Mobile 5 and 6

	Multiple distributions	Support for most commonly used Linux distributions, like Redhat, SuSE, Ubuntu, Centos and Debian
	PHP-MAPI extension	Integration with other (PHP) applications is very simple via PHP-MAPI extension

	Mail delivery in Public Folders	You can deliver for email to a specific folder in the Public Folder
	Various backup methods	All Zarafa data is stored in a MySQL database, you can use several MySQL backup tools
	Bricklevel backup	Bricklevel backup tool to backup and restore single mailboxes, folders or items
	Single Sign On	Automatically use your Windows username and password to login on the Zarafa server
	Multi domain support	Possibility to run Zarafa for several organisations on a single server. *Available in specific hosted Zarafa version
